

Consent of Responsibility Form

This form must be signed and returned prior to leaving for Camp

I understand that if I am contacted by a Student Minister of First Baptist Raytown and notified that my student has broken a rule at Camp and must go home, that I have to pick up my student within eight (8) hours from the time I was notified.

Students Boat/Jet Ski Recreation Time

Safety is the number one concern!!!

Everyone must wear a lifejacket in the boat or on the Jet Ski.

No one under 21 is allowed to drive any watercraft.

JET SKIING

All passengers need to know how to swim and be aware of the risk of falling off the Jet Ski into the water.

Jet ski drivers have been given a maximum speed. Do not ask them to speed up.

Do not ask your driver to ride **within 100 feet** of a boat and jump their wakes or spray boats by doing a spin...**it is illegal.**

No Jet Skis will be used for pulling tubes.

Must have 1/2 ratio of male/female driver/riders or 1/1 ratio of male/male or female/female driver/rider.

BOATING

Boat drivers have been given a maximum speed for pulling tubes. Do not ask the driver to go faster.

No mixed (male/female) in the one tube, same sex only may ride in one tube.

No tube wars allowed when pulling two tubes behind one boat!

Please let the boat rider know what kind of a skier or wake boarder you are: beginner, intermediate, or advanced.

Let the driver know what speed you are used to skiing.

Review the hand signals: Skier OK, Speed OK, Slow Down, Speed Up, and Stop. Show them how to use their skis for safety when down in the water (skis form X out of the water – or holding one ski high in the water).
